Make Those Words!

This literacy activity is used to reinforce the blending of syllables in words

Grade Level, Standard, and Objective

Grade: 2nd

Standard: R.F.2.3 Know and apply grade-level phonics and word analysis skills in decoding words

Objective(s): Students will construct two syllable words when given syllable cards. Students will rewrite two syllable words that correspond with given pictures.



Directions: Give the student the worksheet with the pictures, lay the syllable cards out in front of them, the students are to choose the two syllable cards that create the word of the pictures provided. If they are not a match they begin again by choosing two more cards. When a word is created they are to write the word on the line or on a separate piece of paper.

Variations:

1. Use the set for **3** syllable words also provided on the website for more of a challenge.

2. Create a more of a variety of syllable cards and have the students attempt to create new words by blending the syllables. The students can then draw pictures to go with the words they have created.
